## Declaration of Ian Wallach, Esq.

- 1. I am counsel to defendant Pedro Martinez in this matter.
- 2. The defense counsel is having difficulty communicating with each other as for security reasons the defendant is placed in between them.
- 3. Unlike the prosecutor, the defense has no office at the Court and needs to travel back and forth from lodging to get trial materials. At times this renders it difficult to process everything that is happening on the stand.
- 4. Upon proper application, the Court should grant counsel permission to use a Court Reporter, as such is in conformity with the California Rules of Court. Cal. Rule of Court. Rule 1.150 (d) Personal recording devices, provides as follows:

The judge may permit inconspicuous personal recording devices to be used by persons in a courtroom to make sound recordings as personal notes of the proceedings. A person proposing to use a recording device must obtain advance permission from the judge. The recordings must not be used for any purpose other than as personal notes.

- 5. A personal recorder would allow the defense the capacity to confirm or clarify testimony and avoid making any misrepresentations based on misremembered testimony. The personal recorder will allow the defense the capacity to assist in its note-taking efforts.
- 6. The recorder will be discretely placed inside a personal item of the defendant's counsel.
- 7. The device will not be used for any purpose other than as personal notes.
